The NBAMRT issues Temporary Practice licenses to applicants who have met the requirements for Temporary Practice licensure as described within Section 4.1.2 of the [NBAMRT Bylaws](#).

An applicant is **NOT** able to commence work until they have received their Temporary Practice license approval from the NBAMRT. This license provides the recent graduate with the right to start employment orientation as an DI-01, while protecting patient and public safety, with the following conditions:

- The technologist must only perform tasks in the specialty for which they have been educated and/or have been trained.
- The technologist must only perform tasks when they are not the only person responsible for the work performed. All tasks, work and/or procedures must be performed **under the direct supervision** of a registered Full Practice MRT who is certified in the same specialty.
- The Temporary Practice license expires upon receipt of the CAMRT Certification Exam results. If unsuccessful, the employee must cease DI-01 duties **immediately, and inquire with the NBAMRT regarding eligibility for license extension. Return to DI-01 duties may not be permitted until an extension has been granted.** If successful, the employee must apply for Full Practice registration as a certified MRT.
- Under no circumstances is a Temporary Practice license holder to supervise or train other employees.

The NBAMRT defines “direct supervision” as having a registered Full Practice MRT in close physical proximity to the Temporary Practice license holder, who will continually supervise and monitor the performance to ensure quality standards and best practice are upheld and be readily accessible for assistance or needed intervention.

By signing below, all parties declare that the above-named applicant/employee will be at all times practicing under the direct supervision of a registered Full Practice MRT and agree to comply with the terms and conditions as described above, within the [NBAMRT Act](#), [By-Laws](#), [Code of Ethics](#) and [Standards of Practice](#) of the New Brunswick Association of Medical Radiation Technologists.
